

The Edge of the Pacific

Sitting mid-way along Vancouver Island's rugged west coast, Tofino has built its reputation as one of Canada's top destinations known for its wild natural beauty, endless beaches, old-growth forests, and abundant marine and wildlife.

Tofino's profile stands alongside Whistler, the Okanagan, Victoria, and Vancouver as one of the province's most recognized destinations. Attracting an estimated 1 million visitors annually, it has become a premier hub for outdoor recreation—built on surfing, whale watching, storm watching, sport fishing, hiking, and beachcombing.

Getting to Tofino is part of the experience. Highway 4 connects the town to Nanaimo through Parksville and Port Alberni, with a scenic drive of two and a half hours. A commercial airport is located just south of town, and direct floatplane service into Tofino's inner harbour allows for quicker access. Harbour Air now offers scheduled flights from downtown Vancouver, with flight times of about an hour from the city or 45 minutes from Vancouver International Airport's river terminal.





Stay a While, feel it All

Ocean Village Beach Resort is situated directly on Mackenzie Beach, one of Tofino's most family friendly beaches. Protected by offshore reefs, it offers a long stretch of soft sand, calm tidal pools, and gentle, consistent waves, making it especially popular with beginner surfers. Unlike the more rugged shores elsewhere on Vancouver Island, MacKenzie Beach is accessible year-round and is one of the few beaches in Tofino where campfires are permitted.

Its peaceful ambiance, protection from strong winds, and stunning sunset views make it the perfect setting for Ocean Village's iconic cabins. Ideally located just minutes from the heart of Tofino, Ocean Village Resort is also easily accessible to some of the west coast's most beloved restaurants, shops, and outdoor experiences—enhancing both guest convenience and the lifestyle appeal of this unique beachfront retreat.






